rationale

The Dyslexia Outreach Service is funded by Norfolk County Council and is part of the Cognition and Learning specialism of Norfolk Specialist Resource Bases (SRBs). In the first instance it is a resource for schools, with an aim to build clusters' capacity to better meet the needs of all learners with specific learning difficulties, including dyslexia, dysgraphia and dyscalculia.

access

The Dyslexia Outreach Service does not provide direct teaching support for individual pupils.

structure

The Dyslexia Outreach Service will work with the Learning and Cognition SRBs, Cluster SEND Adviser, an Educational Psychologist and a Complex Needs School Partner to give you the best support available.

It works in all keystages, from ages 5—18 and its services can be accessed by any Norfolk school.

Dyslexia Outreach teachers will travel to schools who make a request and will work with the SENDCo to develop an action plan regarding the request for dyslexia support.



finance

The Dyslexia Outreach Service provides a free core service of support to all schools.

There will be a cost element to all training activities, diagnostic assessment and exam access arrangements.

staffing

The Dyslexia Outreach Service is staffed by three experienced and practising teachers, all of whom hold higher level and/or specialist qualifications for the teaching and assessment of pupils with dyslexia.

Teachers have experience in all phases of education.
