What is CCET & AAC?

The Certificate of Competence in Educational Testing (CCET) will enable the participant to confidently understand the principles involved in educational testing and carry out that testing themselves.

A successful completion of the CCET will lead to the British Psychological Society Test User Educational qualification (*optional additional registration fee & annual subscription to BPS is not included in the course fees*).

It will enable the participant to undertake the additional Access Arrangements Course (AAC) to become a Specialist Assessor as defined by JCQ regulations and required from Sept 2017.

CCET content

- understand the purposes of testing & assessment
- become familiar with theories about testing & psychometrics
- understand the legislative and policy framework
- select, evaluate, administer and interpret different types of educational tests
- carry out an assessment of a learner and report the findings

Course assessment
