

## What are the costs?

### Full cost for non member school

5 training workshops @£50 = £250

Gateway qualification fee = £50

## Is this qualification for me?

This qualification is for you if you

- are interested in dyslexia and want to further your understanding of dyslexia
- work with pupils with dyslexia between the ages of 5 and 18
- you work in a classroom setting and want to get better at differentiating for learners with dyslexia

This course is a balance of theory and practical strategies.

Please note that a Level 3 course is equivalent to an A level standard.

### Certification

The qualification will be awarded based on activities completed during workshops as well as independent learning. This will be compiled into a portfolio of evidence.

## What will I learn?

You will learn

- different definitions of dyslexia
- characteristic features of dyslexia
- the social, emotional and behavioural impact of dyslexia
- what issues are faced by dyslexic learners when learning to read, spell and write
- how dyslexia may affect the development of numeracy skills
- what assessments are available and how they might be used
- many different strategies for addressing the barriers to learning that individuals with dyslexia may face, including use of assistive technology
- sources of support

## What are the course requirements?

- You will need to attend 5 training workshops (each 2.5 hours in length) - see attached workshop list.
- You are able to select any workshop based on your interests and their relevance to you.
- There will also be an element of independent work around general dyslexia awareness for which you will receive all relevant resources and guidance.

### How long will it take me to gain my qualification?

- You will gain your L3 qualification as soon as you have met all the required criteria. This could take as little as 12 weeks or as long as 12 months.
