

Free assistive technology readily available

- On iphones/ipad:
 - a) Siri for speech recognition. This works whenever you get up a keyboard (click the microphone icon) – no training needed. It is also possible to navigate the internet with it.
 - b) Accessibility speech: for text to speech
 - c) **Predictive text**: this works on IOS8 whenever you get up a keyboard (select the appropriate word as it appears at the top of the keyboard)
 - d) **Predictive text**: Spell Better (free from the app store)
- On laptops/PCs/tablets:
 - a) Most newish computers come with speech recognition and text to speech. Type the required technology in 'search programs and files' in the start button. Before using speech recognition some training is required and this is not necessarily child friendly.
 - b) **Speech Recognition** without training: Dragon Naturally Speaking App for touch screens and tablets
 - c) Speech Recognition that is child friendly: Dragon Naturally Speaking (about £100) – some training needed.
- General:
 - a) Mobile phone/tablet **camera** for photos of homework and notes on the board, for example.

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
