Signposting

Clear labelling all around school – use of colour/images to support any text

Classroom door labelling – colour/number /photograph

Visual timetables in use and on display where appropriate

Library

Library has books in a range of print formats to incorporate dyslexia friendly titles.

Alternative resources to access text are available within the library, such as audio or speech assisted e-readers.

If books are available in classrooms, they accommodate a range of reading abilities.

Technology

Computers/mobile devices have dyslexia friendly accessibility features enabled.

Information about dyslexia

Printed information is in a dyslexia friendly font style and on an off white background where possible

Where information on dyslexia is available, it is clearly & accessibly displayed

Staff are aware of where to find information on dyslexia including tips for dyslexia friendly practice.
